- The deadline to fill out our Event Access Form is **Monday, March 29, 2027.**
- ***If you have a CAC, Retired Military ID, or Fort Shafter DBIDS (other installations not accepted) you can access Fort Shafter without being sponsored onto the installation and you do not need to fill out our security form.***
- You will need to present the Gate Guard with a REAL ID-compliant Driver's License. If you do not have a REAL ID Driver's License, bring a Passport or Passport Card.
- **If you submit security information to us, you do not have to go to the Visitor Processing Center at Tripler when you arrive.** Our Event Access List will be posted at the Fort Shafter main gate (Buckner Gate).
- Please tell the Gate Guard – *"I am on an Event Access List (EAL) for the C5 Forum taking place at the Hale Ikena (Community Activity Center at the Golf Course)."*

DIRECTIONS

FROM WAIKIKI: (approximately 20 minutes)

- Take the H-1 West from Waikiki.
- On H1-West keep left at the fork to merge onto H-201 W, follow signs for Interstate H-201 W/Aiea/Fort Shafter.
- Next, take a right onto Exit 4 Fort Shafter/Ahua Street onto Kikowaena Road.
- Follow the roadway downhill to the Fort Shafter Main Gate (Buckner Gate). After the gate guard verifies your access, proceed onto Funston Road.
- **Our Event Access List will be posted at the Gate, and you do not have to stop at the Visitor Processing Center at Tripler if you submitted your security information to us. Please tell the Gate Guard – “I am on an Event Access List (EAL) for the C5 Forum taking place at the Hale Ikena Community Center at the Golf Course.”**
- Once the Guard has verified you, you will drive back up the hill and make a right at the stop sign back onto Funston Road.
- From Funston Road you will make a left on Carter Drive from the left-turn-only lane.
- Follow Carter Drive and take a sharp right uphill onto Morton Drive.
- The entrance to Hale Ikena is on the left.

PARKING & PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Ample open parking is available in front of the Hale Ikena.

Public transportation such as Ubers or Taxis, will not be allowed to access Fort Shafter.

SHIPPING & EQUIPMENT INFORMATION
